- High student interest and involvement;
- You insisted that classroom routines of raising their hands be followed;
- Good practice to record their ideas on the flip chart;
- Good transition to circle group;
- Excellent impromptu circle activity to develop the plot of the fairytale;
- Most children were able to continue the plot development when it came around to their turn;
- Good judgment to wrap up this activity after fifteen minutes;
- Good template prepared to write their own conclusion to the story they had just developed;
- Clear explanation of the expectations;
- Your students began the activity immediately;
- You monitored the activity very well. You were helpful when required;
- Some students wrote good resolutions to the fairytale, but there were several that were struggling;
- You sustained a very positive learning environment throughout the period.


Suggestions for improvement:
